



Revised conditions of entry re COVID-19 to Wauchope Arts Council events (effective 16/10/20)

Background

As we re-commence Wauchope Community Arts Council performances and events, the safety of everyone involved is of paramount importance. We have put measures in place to prioritise health and wellbeing based on the following core principles:

- Creating a safe environment – introducing limits around the number of people allowed within each space, installing signage regarding social distancing and providing contactless ticketing and venue check-in
- Introducing new hygiene protocols, increased cleaning and disinfecting, and providing hand sanitiser
- Introducing COVID-19 appropriate conditions of entry which reflect these core principles and apply equally to Wauchope Arts volunteers/crew.

Please note: Conditions of entry may be updated at any time and at short notice, in line with changing gov t guidelines, local conditions and to cater for different venues and event types.

Conditions of entry

ALL audience members, performers, crew and volunteers will be required to check-in on arrival (via QR code scan or manual list) and to observe social-distancing measures (as per the NSW Health guidelines).

At some venues and events, everyone except performers will be required to wear a mask inside the venue.

The booking process has been revised to identify group sales from the same household/bubble which allows them to be seated together. Honesty is a vital component of this process and patrons are required to advise if there are any changes to group bookings.

Visitors are not permitted to enter Wauchope Arts events if they:

- are experiencing flu-like symptoms (sore throat, runny nose, persistent cough, shortness of breath, fever)
- have been in close contact with a person who has recently tested positive for COVID-19
- are awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19
- reside with anyone who is awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19
- have returned from international or interstate (where relevant) travel and failed to observe the government requirement to quarantine for 14 days.

Visitors who are not subject to any of the above conditions for exclusion must be willing and able to agree to the following requirements to:

- provide Wauchope Arts Council with their name and contact details and consent to the provision of their contact details to the NSW Department of Health or any other third-party government department, as and if required to enable contact tracing procedures
- leave the site immediately if they become unwell, after notifying a crew/staff member
- to follow directions from Wauchope Arts crew, venue staff and COVID-19 marshals
- maintain personal hand hygiene by washing their hands and/or using hand sanitiser
- maintain good respiratory hygiene by coughing or sneezing into their elbow or a tissue
- acknowledge that they may be asked to wait, or to move in order to manage audience proximity and venue capacity under NSW Health social distancing requirements
- respond accurately to the questions if asked by Wauchope Arts crew, venue staff or volunteers
- acknowledge the right of Wauchope Arts to refuse entry or request your departure for any reason
- at all times, treat crew, staff, volunteers and other visitors with respect.
