



Revised Conditions of Entry to Wauchope Community Arts Council events (effective 19/1/22)

Background

As we move into our 2022 program of performances and events, the safety of everyone involved is of paramount importance.

We have a COVID-Safety Plan designed to prioritise the wellbeing of performers, audience members, volunteers and their families based on the following core principles:

- Creating a safe work, entertainment and volunteering environment
- Introducing appropriate hygiene and social distancing protocols
- Introducing COVID-19 appropriate conditions of entry which apply equally to performers, audience members and Wauchope Arts volunteers/crew.

Please note: conditions of entry may be updated at any time and at short notice, in line with changing govt guidelines and local conditions and/or case numbers.

Conditions of entry vary

The conditions of entry to Wauchope Arts-hosted events will vary according to the event type, whether the event is held inside or outdoors, how many performing artists are involved, the type of performance and the COVID-safety measures the performing artist(s) prefer in terms of audience number, social-distancing and vaccination status.

For this reason, conditions of entry will vary from event to event.

Please check the conditions of entry for each event prior to arrival/ticket purchase to ensure you comply.

Indoor events

All indoor events are ticketed and the conditions of entry are clearly outlined on the Trybooking ticketing page for each event.

Check-in (via QR code scan or manual list) and social-distancing are required at all indoor events.

Some indoor events will only be open to fully vaccinated audience members and volunteers.

At some indoor events, audience members and volunteers will be required to wear a mask inside the venue.

Please check the conditions of entry prior to purchase to ensure you comply.

Outdoor events

Most will be unticketed and free of charge – our gift to the community.

Outdoor events are open to all audience members and volunteers, regardless of vaccination status.

Check-in (via QR code scan or manual list) and social-distancing are required.

Please do not attend any Wauchope Arts events if you:

- are experiencing flu-like symptoms
- have been in close contact with a COVID-positive person
- are awaiting the results of a test for COVID-19 or reside with someone awaiting test results.

At all events, visitors must agree to:

- follow directions and respond accurately to questions from Wauchope Arts crew and volunteers
- treat crew, volunteers, performers, other visitors and the local environment with respect.
